

Horizon Europe's call for Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowship (**HORIZON-MSCA-2021-PF-01**) is now open.

This Post-Doctoral Fellowship Programme offers excellent chance to PhD holders with limited post-PhD experience to undertake mobility to EU Member States (European Postdoctoral Fellowships) by undertaking original/innovative and personalized research projects and acquire new skills and experience.

**Deadline to apply online: Oct 12, 2021**

**Who can apply:** Candidates who have submitted their PhD thesis, or have less than 8 years of Post-PhD research experience with exceptions

**Programme Purpose:** The objective is to improve research career opportunities, with focus on interdisciplinary approach within academia or beyond.

**Programme Duration:** Between 12 and 24 months, can be extended with justification for an additional period of up to six months

**Application Procedure:** The students must apply online, it is two part application process submitted electronically, Part A is filled online on portal (instructions), Part B (B1 and B2) can be uploaded in pdf format (details here).

Also submit a digital summary (Candidate and Host Details, Project topic etc.) copy to International Relations office (email) with **subject line** IITR-MSCA-PF-2021.

**NOTE:** Host organization can be any public or private sector research actors (universities research institutes-private companies). The Host Institute can be in any of the EU 27 Member States and in any of the countries associated to Horizon Europe.
