KHORANA Program for SCHOLARS

The Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India, the Indo-U.S. Science and Technology Forum (IUSSTF) and WINStep Forward are partnering to support the prestigious Khorana Program for Scholars named in honor of Dr. Har Gobind Khorana, who won the Nobel Prize in 1968 for his work at the interface of Chemistry and Biology while a member of the University of Wisconsin-Madison faculty. The Khorana Program will provide opportunities to Indian students to undertake research at leading U.S. universities over Summer 2023 for a period of 10-12 weeks.

The Khorana Program is envisaged to:

- Provide an opportunity to Indian students to gain exposure and access to world class research facilities
- Promote research and capacity building in frontline areas of biotechnology
- Encourage post-graduate students to take up research as a career
- Pave the way for the next generation of scientists and technologists towards building long-term sustainable R&D linkages and collaborations

Eligibility:

- Pre-final year students enrolled in B.Tech., M. Tech., MSc., B.E., M.E., M.S., Integrated B.S-M.S., B.Sc., B.V.Sc., M.V.Sc., B. Pharm., M. Pharm., MBBS., and Master in Medical Science and Technology (MMST) at recognized institutions of higher education in India in Biotechnology and allied areas are eligible to apply.
- First Year, Final Year and Ph.D. students are NOT eligible to apply.
